ORDER

This court finds that the statements made by defendant in the petition above are true, and that the rehabilitation of defendant has attained to the satisfaction of this court.

It is ordered, therefore, that:

1. All records in defendant's case in the custody of this court, or in the custody of any other agency, or official, shall be sealed and expunged, pursuant to the provisions of section 77-18-2, UCA 1953 as amended.
2. Upon entry of this order, defendant shall be deemed judicially pardoned, and he/she may respond to any inquiries in relation to conviction of crimes as though the conviction described above had never occurred.
3. Copies of this order shall be sent to the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification, the Salt Lake County District Attorney's Office, the _____ Police Department and the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office.
4. The arresting agency shall request the return to that agency of defendant's fingerprints record with regard to the above matter from the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and
5. Inspection of the records in defendant's case in this court, and such records held by any other court, agency, or official, shall hereafter be permitted by this court only upon the petition of defendant to this court, and shall be inspected only by the persons named in such petition for inspection.
