

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION DISPOSAL



Did you know that up to 17 percent of prescribed medication goes unused, and if improperly disposed, may contribute to drug diversion and environmental problems?

Teenagers now abuse prescription drugs more than any other illegal drug except for marijuana, and the majority of teens who abuse these drugs get them for free, usually from friends and relatives and often without their knowledge.

Most people don't realize that water treatment facilities do not test or treat for medications. Because of improper disposal, detectable amounts of discarded medication are showing up in the waterways across the country.

Do your part and dispose of your old medications properly. If you are unable to bring them to a medication drop-off site, please add water and dish soap to each bottle and wrap in duct tape before placing in the trash.



Old medications should never be disposed of down the toilet.

Yes – Accepted

Prescriptions, over-the-counter medications, vitamins, samples, medications for pets, ointments, lotions, liquid medication in glass or leak-proof containers

No – NOT Accepted

Needles (Sharps), thermometers, bloody or infectious waste, medication from businesses or clinics, hydrogen peroxide, aerosol cans, inhalers
